VICK STAGGER OFF BALANCE HAVING TO BRACE HIMSELF TO KEEP FROM FALLING ON A CONCRETE WALL NEXT TO THE ENTRANCE OF THE STATEHOUSE GARAGE. MR. VICK PROCEEDED TO ROUND

NARRATIVE

THE CORNER AND WALK INTO THE GARAGE OUT OF MY SIGHT. I MADE MY WAY INTO THE GARAGE IN AN ATTEMPT TO LOCATE THE INDIVIDUAL AND SHORTLY AFTER ENTERING THE GARAGE I HEARD A NOISE CONSISTENT WITH A CAR STARTING ITS ENGINE. I PROCEEDED TO WALK TOWARDS THE NOISE OF THE CAR STARTING AND NOTICED A WHITE IN COLOR VEHICLE (SC TAG NUMBER RE51A) MAKING ITS WAY TOWARD THE EXIT. MR. VICK WAS HAVING TROUBLE DRIVING IN A STRAIGHT LINE AND WHILE TRYING TO MAKE HIS WAY THROUGH A FLEX CONE AND A CONCRETE WALL, MR. VICK RAN OVER THE FLEX CONE WITH THE FRONT BUMPER OF HIS VEHICLE. I CALLED OUT VERBALLY FOR THE VEHICLE TO STOP AND MR. VICK COMPLIED. UPON APPROACHING MR. VICK IN HIS STOPPED VEHICLE, THIS OFFICER NOTICED A STRONG ODOR OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE EMITTING FROM MR. VICK'S BREATH. WHILE TALKING TO MR. VICK, I NOTICED THE VEHICLE TO BE IN THE DRIVE POSITION SO I ASKED MR. VICK TO PLACE THE VEHICLE IN THE PARK POSITION. MR. VICK DID NOT COMPLY WITH MY REQUESTS UNTIL A LATER TIME. AFTER EVENTUALLY PLACING THE VEHICLE IN THE PARK POSITION, I ASKED MR. VICK TO TURN OFF THE CAR AND HE CONTINUOUSLY RESPONDED BY ASKING THE QUESTION WHY. WHEN I ASKED MR. VICK TO STEP OUT OF THE VEHICLE, HE PLACED THE VEHICLE BACK INTO THE DRIVE POSITION. AFTER ANOTHER SERIES OF REQUESTS TO PLACE THE VEHICLE IN THE PARK POSITION AND STEP OUT OF THE VEHICLE, MR. VICK FINALLY COMPLIED. ONCE IT WAS SAFE TO DO SO, I REACHED INTO MR. VICK'S VEHICLE TO TURN THE CAR OFF AND REMOVED THE KEYS FROM THE IGNITION. I THEN ASKED MR. VICK FOR HIS DRIVER'S LICENSE AND MR. VICK SAID THAT IT WAS IN HIS VEHICLE. I ASKED MR. VICK WHERE HIS WALLET WAS LOCATED AND IF I COULD REACH IN THERE TO OBTAIN IT FOR HIM. MR. VICK COMPLIED WITH MY REQUEST AND I RETRIEVED A BROWN IN COLOR WALLET FROM THE CENTER CONSOLE OF HIS VEHICLE AND GAVE IT TO MR. VICK SO HE COULD OPEN IT AND GIVE ME HIS DRIVER'S LICENSE. I THEN RAN MR. VICK'S DRIVER'S LICENSE THROUGH DISPATCH WHICH CAME BACK CLEAR. I THEN ASKED FOR THE STATEHOUSE TO SEND SOMEONE FROM THE GOVERNOR'S MANSION WITH A PATROL CAR TO ASSIST. L/CPL HOFFMAN ARRIVED AND ASSISTED ME IN DEALING WITH MR. VICK. L/CPL HOFFMAN STATED THAT HE DID NOT HAVE A CAMERA IN HIS PATROL CAR SO I ASKED L/CPL HOFFMAN TO WATCH MR. VICK WHILE I WENT TO ACQUIRE A VEHICLE THAT HAD A CAMERA IN IT. AFTER RETURNING WITH THE PATROL CAR AND POSITIONING IT TO DO A STANDARDIZED FIELD SOBRIETY TEST, I ASKED MR. VICK TO WALK IN FRONT OF THE PATROL CAR TO DO A SERIES OF TEST. MR. VICK REFUSED TO COMPLY WITH MY REQUEST. I ATTEMPTED TO ESCORT MR. VICK TO THE FRONT OF THE PATROL CAR. MR. VICK FAILED TO COMPLY WITH MY REQUEST AND STARTED TO RESIST BY PULLING AWAY FROM ME. L/CPL HOFFMAN AND I WERE ABLE TO GAIN CONTROL OF MR. VICK AND

NARRATIVE

TOOK HIM TO THE BACK OF HIS VEHICLE AND ATTEMPTED TO PLACE HANDCUFFS ON HIM. MR. VICK AT THIS POINT TIGHTENED UP HIS ARMS AND PULLED THEM TIGHTLY TO THE LOWER PART OF HIS BACK MAKING IT HARD FOR ME TO PLACE HANDCUFFS ON HIM. L/CPL HOFFMAN AND I WERE ABLE TO PULL HIS ARM AWAY FROM HIS BODY AND GET THE HANDCUFFS ON AT 11:08PM ON 05/14/2013. MR. VICK WAS PLACED UNDER ARREST FOR SUSPICION OF DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE AND WAS ADVISED OF HIS MIRANDA RIGHTS. MR. VICK STATED TO THIS OFFICER THAT HE UNDERSTOOD THE RIGHTS HE HAS AS THEY WERE EXPLAINED TO HIM. MR. VICK WAS SEARCHED AND TRANSPORTED TO ALVIN S. GLENN DETENTION CENTER WITH BEGINNING MILEAGE 124019 AND ENDING MILEAGE 124027. CPL ELLIOTT WITH THE SOUTH CAROLINA HIGHWAY PATROL MET WITH ME AT THE DETENTION CENTER TO CONDUCT THE DATAMASTER EXAM. ONCE IN THE DATAMASTER ROOM, CPL ELLIOTT ADVISED MR. VICK OF HIS MIRANDA RIGHTS AGAIN TO WHICH MR. VICK REPLIED THAT HE UNDERSTOOD THE RIGHTS AS THEY HAD BEEN EXPLAINED TO HIM. WHILE CPL ELLIOTT WAS ENTERING INFORMATION INTO THE DATAMASTER MACHINE, I NOTICED MR. VICK TO BE STARING AT ME IN AN UNUSUAL MANNER FOR AN ABNORMAL PERIOD OF TIME. MR. VICK AT ONE POINT CROSSES HIS ARM AND CONTINUES WITH THE STARES AND CPL ELLIOTT HAD TO ASK HIM MULTIPLE TIMES TO SIT DOWN IN THE CHAIR BEFORE COMPLYING TO DO SO. MR. VICK CONTINUED THIS BEHAVIOR WHILE CPL ELLIOTT GAVE HIM A COPY OF HIS IMPLIED CONSENT RIGHTS AND READ THEM TO HIM. CPL ELLIOTT THEN ASKED MR. VICK IF HE WOULD BE WILLING TO ANSWER QUESTIONS IF ASKED. MR. VICK RESPONDED BY SAYING THAT HE WOULD BE WILLING TO DO SO. WHEN ASKED WHERE MR. VICK WAS COMING FROM, HE STATED THAT HE HAD PREVIOUSLY BEEN AT COWBOY'S BRAZILIAN STEAKHOUSE ON MAIN STREET. WHEN ASKED HOW MANY DRINKS MR. VICK HAD CONSUMED WHILE AT COWBOY'S HE RESPONDED BY SAYING THAT HE HAD A FEW. CPL ELLIOTT PROCEEDED TO ASK HOW MANY A FEW WAS AND MR. VICK RESPONDED BY SAYING THAT HE ONLY HAD 2 GLASSES OF CABERNET WINE. MR. VICK ALSO TOLD THESE OFFICERS WHILE IN THE DATAMASTER ROOM THAT HE HAD WALKED FROM COWBOY'S ON MAIN STREET BACK TO THE STATEHOUSE. WHEN ASKED WHETHER OR NOT MR. VICK FELT COMFORTABLE DRIVING HAVING 2 DRINKS AND WHETHER OR NOT HIS BODY HAD A TOLERANCE TO 2 DRINKS TO ALLOW HIM TO DRIVE, MR. VICK STATED THAT HE BELIEVED HE DID. MR. VICK WAS ALSO ASKED IF HE WOULD NORMALLY DRIVE IN HIS CURRENT STATE TO WHICH HE REPLIED, "NO, I HAVE DRIVERS." WHEN THE 20 MINUTE WAITING PERIOD WAS UP AND IT CAME TIME FOR MR. VICK TO GIVE A SAMPLE, MR. VICK REFUSED TO TAKE THE DATAMASTER BREATH TEST IN THE 2-MINUTE ALLOTTED TIME. MR. VICK WAS LEFT IN THE CUSTODY OF ALVIN S. GLENN DETENTION CENTER PERSONNEL. TICKET NUMBER D360620 WAS ISSUED.
