Rand Paul Victory Committee ("RPVC") allocates contributions to Rand Paul for US Senate 2016 ("RPFS") and Reinventing A New Direction – RANDPAC ("RANDPAC") in conformity with federal limits. The maximum an individual may contribute to RPVC is \$10,400. The maximum amount a federal multi-candidate political action committee may contribute to RPVC is \$15,000. The maximum amount a federal political action committee that is not a multi-candidate committee may contribute to RPVC is \$10,400.

Contributions to RPVC shall be allocated by the following formula:

- 1. Individuals and non-multicandidate PACs-The first \$2,700 will go to RPFS's primary account. The next \$5,000 will go to RANDPAC's account. The next \$2,700 will go to RPFS's general account.
- 2. Multicandidate PACs–The first \$5,000 will go to RPFS's primary account. The next \$5,000 will go to RANDPAC's account. The next \$5,000 will go to RPFS's general account.

Notwithstanding this allocation formula, a contributor may designate a contribution for a specific participant. In addition, the allocation formula may change if any contribution would exceed federal contribution limits. Contributions to RPVC are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. Contributions from corporations, labor unions, federal contractors, and foreign nationals are prohibited. Federal law requires us to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation, and name of employer of each contributor whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$200 in a calendar year (RANDPAC) or election cycle (RPFS).

In addition, the allocation formula may change if any contribution would exceed federal contribution limits. Contributions to RPVC are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes.
