

Executive Summary

Gravis Marketing, a nonpartisan research firm, conducted a random survey of 1,019 registered voters in South Carolina regarding the presidential election. The sample includes 609 Republican Primary participants and 209 Democratic Primary participants, with the remainder being non-Primary participants that will vote in the 2016 General Election. The poll has a margin of error of \pm 3% for the total sample, \pm 4% for the Republican Primary, and \pm 6% for the Democratic Primary. The total may not round to 100% because of rounding. The polls were conducted using IVR technology and weighted separately for each population in the question presented. The poll was conducted for One America News Network.










What is your political ideology?


Do you consider yourself a member of the Tea Party?


Do you or anyone in your family own a gun or firearm?


Do you consider yourself to be Pro-Life or Pro-Choice when it comes to the question of whether or not abortion should be legal?






Which of the following best represents your religious affiliation?

Religious affiliation




What is the highest level of education have you completed?
