ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME, ALISHA WRIGHT CONTACTED THIS OFFICER AND ASKED FOR A REPORT ON WHAT SHE DESCRIBED AS AN ASSAULT THAT OCCURRED ON 3/13/18. MS WRIGHT STATES THAT SHE WAS CALLED IN FOR A PERFORMANCE BASED CONFERENCE IN THE OFFICE OF TRACY WATFORD WITH HER SUPERVISOR JODY STEIGERWALT. MS WRIGHT SAID THE CONVERSATION WAS LOUD ON THE PART OF BOTH PARTIES AND THAT MS STEIGERWALT TOOK A CONTAINER OF MAIL THAT MS WRIGHT HAD NOT PROCESSED AND KNOCKED IT TOWARDS MS WRIGHT'S FEET AND STATED 'MAKE TIME'. MS WRIGHT STATES THAT THE MAIL HIT HER LEGS AND ANKLES AND THAT SHE ASKED TO LEAVE AND WAS ALLOWED TO DO SO. MS WRIGHT STATES THAT THE NEXT MORNING

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SHE MET WITH MS WATFORD AND MELISSA DUNLAP TO DISCUSS THE EVENTS. MS WRIGHT STATES THAT SHE RESIGNED DUE TO THE BAD WORK CONDITIONS. THIS OFFICER DID INTERVIEW MS STEIGERWALT, MS WATFORD AND MS DUNLAP WHO ALL STATE THAT DURING THE INITIAL CONFERENCE WITH MS WRIGHT IN REGARDS TO HER PERFORMANCE, MS WRIGHT BECAME SO LOUD THAT UNINVOLVED COWORKERS WERE DISTURBED BY IT AND THAT MS WRIGHT SLAMMED THE OFFICE DOOR AND SAID 'THIS IS SOME BULL SHIT' AS SHE LEFT. STEIGERWALT, DUNLAP AND WATFORD STATE THAT, AT THAT TIME, A TERMINATION ACTION WAS DRAWN UP AND THAT WHEN MS WRIGHT RETURNED THE NEXT DAY SHE WAS APOLOGETIC AND EXPRESSED AN INTEREST IN RESIGNING. DUNLAP STATES THAT WRIGHT WAS ALLOWED TO RESIGN RATHER THAN BE TERMINATED.
