CHARLESTON MAN CHARGED WITH CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT, GIVING BEER OR WINE TO UNDERAGE PERSON

Agents of the S.C. Law Enforcement Division Wednesday arrested a Charleston man in connection with criminal sexual conduct and providing beer or wine to an underage person.

Kenneth Gregory Boes, 56, was charged with Criminal sexual conduct-third degree and Giving beer or wine to a minor.

The request for the SLED investigation was made by The Citadel Military College.

Boes was booked at the Al Cannon Detention Center in Charleston County.

The case will be prosecuted by the Ninth Circuit Solicitor's Office.

AFFIDAVIT

Personally appeared before me, a magistrate of this County, one, Special Agent David Owen, of the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED), who, first being duly sworn, deposes and says that

KENNETH GREGORY BOES

did within this County and State on or between the 1st day of September, 2017, and the 30th day of April, 2018, violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particulars:

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT 3rd DEGREE 16-3-654

The affiant states that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime(s) set forth, and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:

That between the dates of September 1, 2017 and April 30, 2018, while in the County and State aforesaid, the above named defendant, KENNETH GREGORY BOES, did commit the offense of violation section 16-3-654 of the South Carolina State Code of Laws, 1976 as amended, CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT 3RD DEGREE, in that he did willfully, unlawfully, and feloniously, commit sexual battery by coercion and/or on a physically helpless victim.

That defendant was a Teach, Advise and Counsel (TAC) Officer with The Citadel Military College, a position of authority, and a Lieutenant Colonel (LTC) in the United States Army Reserve. The victim (DOB who will be named later, was a student Cadet at The Citadel. The defendant and victim did form a mentor type relationship.

That during the months of July and August 2017, the victim did visit the defendant's on-campus residence several times in which the victim was provided, and did consume intoxicating beverages and participated in in-depth conversations.

That during the 2017 Fall Academic Semester the defendant and victim became work out partners, visiting the gymnasium on numerous occasions. That on or about September 29, 2017, after leaving the gym, the victim and defendant visited the defendant's campus office. While in the defendant's office, with the door closed and locked, the defendant did forcibly kiss the victim on his lips. The kiss was unsolicited.

That on or about November 10, 2017, the victim was invited to the defendant's on-campus residence for dinner. The defendant did provide the victim with alcoholic beverages that the victim consumed. The defendant also provided the victim with two unknown white pills which the defendant said would prevent a hangover. The victim became light headed and dizzy. While the victim was physically helpless, the defendant began to perform unsolicited oral sex on the victim. The victim blacked out as the oral sex continued. The victim awoke nude the next morning in the same bed as the defendant, who was also nude. The victim inquired as to the events of the previous evening and the defendant replied that it was "Quid Pro Quo" for what he had done for the victim.

That over the course of the remaining Fall Semester, and the following Spring semester, the defendant repeatedly provided the victim with intoxicating beverages and also used coercion, in his position of authority over the victim, to commit multiple sexual batteries on the victim without the victim's consent.

That as a TAC Officer at The Citadel, the defendant was in a position of authority over the victim. TAC Officers may issue and reduce punishments on cadets. TAC Officers may also award cadets leave that authorizes a cadet to leave campus. The defendant did have the victim's punishments reduced and did have the victim awarded leave that the victim did not earn to accommodate the victim.

The above information was revealed through the investigation of SS/A Teresa Beacham and S/A Owen, and they, along with the victim's statement, are witness to prove the same against the form of the statute in such case made and provided against the peace and dignity of the State.

Personally appeared before me, a magistrate of this County, one, <u>Special Agent David Owen</u>, of the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED), who, first being duly sworn, deposes and says that

KENNETH GREGORY BOES

did within this County and State on or between the 20th day of July, 2017, and the 26th day of March, 2018, violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particulars:

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE TRANSFER OF BEER TO PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF TWENTY-ONE 61-4-90

The affiant states that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime(s) set forth, and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:

That between the dates of July 20, 2017, and March 26, 2018, while in the County and State aforesaid, the above named defendant, KENNETH GREGORY BOES, did commit the offense of violation section 61-4-90 of the South Carolina State Code of Laws, 1976 as amended, TRANSFER OF BEER TO PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF TWENTY-ONE, in that he did willfully and unlawfully transfer beer, by providing and allowing victim (DOB , who will be named later, to consume beer in his presence.

At the time of the offenses, the defendant Boes, was a Teach, Advise and Counsel (TAC) Officer with The Citadel Military College, a position of authority, and a Lieutenant Colonel (LTC) in the United States Army Reserve. The victim was a student Cadet at The Citadel.

That on May 23, 2018, the victim provided a signed written statement that the defendant did provide him with beer on numerous occasions and allowed him to consume beer and other intoxicating beverages beginning in or about the month of July 2017.

That on June 1, 2018, S/A Owen interviewed defendant Boes. The defendant was provided his Miranda Rights which he signed, waived and stated he understood. During the interview, the defendant admitted to providing the victim with beer and to allowing the victim to consume the beer in his presence. This occurred in the defendant's residence, located on the campus of The Citadel, and at various restaurants and/ or bars within the County of Charleston. The defendant further admitted he knew at the time of the incidents that the victim was under the age of twenty-one.

The above information was revealed through the investigation of SS/A Teresa Beacham and S/A Owen, and they, along with the victim's statement, are witness to prove the same against the form of the statute in such case made and provided against the peace and dignity of the State.
