

2019 Legislative Scorecard



PERSONHOOD COSPONSOR (H. 3289): The most prolife bill introduced in South Carolina, it declares that life begins at conception and is due protection under the Constitution. Without life, there can be no exercise of other liberties.

PROHIBIT TEEN TANNING (H. 3807): A bill that prohibited tanning for those under 18, even with parental consent. Teen tanning may not be wise, but neither is fast food or any number of other things. This is an example of the nanny state. This should be left between teens and their parents.

CAROLINA PANTHER'S TAX BREAK (H. 4243): Pro sports can create jobs and stimulate economic development. No particular industry, though, should receive special tax treatment as this pits small businesses against large businesses and distorts the market.

CONSTITUTIONAL CARRY (H. 3456): As life is the most fundamental right, the ability to protect life is of the utmost importance. This bill would allow for carrying a firearm without a permit. Requiring a free citizen to obtain a permit is an abridgement of the Second Amendment.

HEARTBEAT BILL – MACE AMENDMENT (H. 3020): The Heartbeat Bill would prohibit abortion after a heartbeat is detected, generally around 6 weeks. Representative Mace introduced an amendment that provides an exception for rape or incest. The innocent, unborn should not suffer for the horrific crimes of the father.

SCHOOL CHOICE COSPONSOR (H. 3202): Senator Tom Davis' school choice bill. This bill would provide for true school choice without unnecessary state interference.

SPORTS MARKETING GRANT (Veto 2): This \$6,500,000.00 budget item is for marketing sports in the hope of bringing in additional revenue. Businesses should stand on their own and not rely on taxpayer support.

RICHLAND ELECTION COMMISSION (Veto 14): After the Richland County Election Commission came under fire for election errors, the state sought this funding to fix the problems of a specific county's organization. Problems like this should be solved as close to the people as possible. This was an issue for the people of Richland County to fix, not the state as a whole.

FOOD MANUFACTURER EQUIPMENT TAX CREDIT (Veto 15): The SC Republican Liberty Caucus believes that taxes should be both lower and fairer. A private business that makes food manufacturing equipment is no more or less worthy of a tax break than a business that makes fans or any other product. The state should not be picking winners and losers in the marketplace.

TABLE STUDY OF FEDERAL FUNDS (Amendment 3 H. 3759): Federal funds come with strings attached. This was a bill to study the cost of receiving federal funds to determine if the costs outweigh the benefit. A motion was made to prevent the study requirement. That motion was defeated.
