Defendants have filed a Motion to Stay the Execution of Judgment. As such, the burden is upon Defendants to convince or persuade this Court that a stay is warranted. City of Spartanburg v. Belk's Dept store, 199 S.C. 458, 20 S.E. 2d 157 (1942).
