Developed for: SC Governor's School of Humanities

Participants: Approximately 77 educators, staff, and administrators

Goal: To support faculty, staff, and administrators in revisioning their department/school regarding more deliberate anti-racist and culturally relevant actions/philosophy.

Impacts:

1. Beginning integration of culturally relevant instruction into syllabi, lessons, and curricula.
2. Awareness of racism and anti-racism.
