**COLUMBIA, S.C.** – An inmate pleaded guilty Monday to charges related to his actions in the 2018 riot at Lee Correctional Institution.

Chan Soheap Bun, 39, who is now housed at McCormick CI, pleaded guilty to possession of contraband and criminal conspiracy. He was sentenced to eight years in prison to run concurrently with his current 30-year sentence. He received 998 days of jail time credit.

Bun's charges involve his part of the riot in housing unit F-5. The contraband refers to weapons he possessed during the incident.

Cases involving other inmates charged in the riot are expected to be scheduled soon.

The agencies thank the S.C. Law Enforcement Division and the S.C. Attorney General's office for its assistance in investigating and prosecuting these cases.
