NARRATIVE

On May 21, 2024 at approximately 1114 hours I, (PPO McCord) and Officer McDermott responded to 13 E Battery Street in reference to an assault that had just occurred.

Upon arriving on scene, officers spoke to Mr. John Lane (victim/complainant). Mr. Lane advised officers that at approximately 1110 hours that day, he was working for his company "Richard Mark Restoration" out front of the 13 E Battery residence while a "Trash Gurl" semi-truck was swapping out dumpsters at residence and was positioned to turn left onto E Battery St. Mr. Lane stated he then observed the driver of a white Range Rover behind the "Trash Gurl" truck step out of his vehicle onto the roadway and walk up to the truck driver (Mr. Bryant) and begin to yell. The truck driver then exited his vehicle. At this time both parties were outside their vehicles. Mr. Lane noticed traffic behind both vehicles start to build up on E Battery St heading North.

Mr. Lane told officers, that at this time he walked up to the suspect and stated "can you please move your vehicle and let this guy out, you are holding up traffic." Mr. Lane made it clear to officers the only reason he had approached the suspect was to mitigate the situation between him and Mr. Bryant. Mr. Lane advised that the suspect and him began to get into a verbal argument. The suspect then used an open hand to strike the left side of Mr. Lane's face causing his sunglasses to fall off his face. Mr. Lane told officers after the assault the suspect admitted to hitting Mr. Lane. The suspect then started telling Mr. Lane where he lived [REDACTED] and who he was, "John Kuhn" and that he was headed home. Mr. Lane stated that he and his work crew were familiar with Mr. Kuhn as they have worked on houses located near his residence in the past. Mr. Lane told officers he was eager to press charges on Mr. Kuhn. Mr. Lane advised he was not injured and did not need EMS. Officers did not observe any lacerations or bruising on Mr. Lane's face, but did see that his left cheek was red.

A witness who was in the area at the time of the assault witnessed the event and captured the ending of their verbal disturbance on her cell phone camera. The witness was then identified verbally as Ms. Teresa Clowney and can be reached by telephone for any questions regarding this incident. Ms. Clowney also advised officers she was familiar with the suspect and identified him as Mr. John Kuhn who resides in the area of Water Street in Charleston, South Carolina.

Due to this incident being freshly committed, officers on scene walked over to [REDACTED] and knocked on the residence in attempt to contact Mr. Kuhn to get his side of the story. No one came to the door, and officers observed an empty driveway. Officers were able to obtain a phone number for Mr. Kuhn using CPD Reporting System. Officers attempted to reach out via phone number and left a voicemail advising him to contact Charleston Police Department regarding the incident.

It should be noted, Mr. Lane advised that the "Trash Gurl" truck's dash cam captured the whole incident. I am still awaiting the email from Mr. Hoty Roberts (Manager of Richard Mark Restoration) with the dash camera footage from the "Trash Gurl" truck. Mr. Roberts can be reached by telephone.
