On 10/13/2022, I was alerted by Det. Sgt. Owens that there was a male arrested last night by Det. Sgt. Butcher who stated he wished to speak with a detective regarding a "murder." I requested to know who the male was and was provided information for Everett Eadie. I was instructed by Det. Sgt. Owens to make my way to Dorchester County Jail and interview the male in reference to the information that he wished to provide to law enforcement. I arrived at the jail with Det. Boehler, and we were shown into the bond hearing room by jail staff. Upon being shown into the room jail staff alerted they would retrieve Everett for the conversation he wished to have. Everett arrived a short time later after we were seated in the room, with both his hands cuffed in the front he sat down in the chair in front of Det. Boehler and I at the table. The time was approximately 0930 hours when Everett was shown in, and I asked if he had requested to speak with a Detective. I did not provide a Miranda Warning to Everett as I have no dealings with him in any investigation and the conversation was not dealing with any charges that he was currently being held for, nor was there any plan of asking about any charges he was being held for. I confirmed with Everett that he wished to speak with investigators and his response took a few moments. Everett stared at the table in front of me and was not speaking but then stated that he had never had "drugs" before and the drugs that were on him a "girl" gave him for "payment" due to her owing him money. Everett was stopped from speaking on the drug charge and I told him I was not concerned with it. I further alerted Everett that I was told he had information he wished to provide, and he stated he was told to speak with the FBI. I asked Everett if that is who he wished to speak with and he stated, "yeah." I told Everett that I was not the FBI and that I worked for DCSO. Everett again stated he was told by the FBI to speak with FBI.

Detective Boehler asked what it was that Everett wished to speak with the FBI about and he stated it was a "murder." Everett further stated that it was a murder involving someone by the name of "DJ Squirrel." Everett stated that the person was called "squirrel" and that he was found on railroad tracks in the Jedburg area. Everett was asked when this occurred and he stated, "a couple years ago." Det. Boehler asked if Everett knew what happened and he stated that he did and that he use to "live with the boys." Everett then redirected again in his conversation that he knew "drug dealers" that he was willing to give up to get out of his charges. I told Everett that I was not worried about the drugs and that I was worried about the murder. I then told Everett that he stated he "lived" with the "boys", and he was asked who the boys were that he lived with. Everett then asked, "am I going to be able to talk with the FBI too, I am willing to talk to y'all too?" I told Everett that he would be able to talk to the FBI if needed. Everett responded with the names of "[REDACTED], [REDACTED]." Everett went quiet as I was writing, and I asked what happened in the murder and if it was just [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Everett responded "yeah, them two, somebody else was driving I forget his name." Everett

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then kept describing the events and that "[redacted] had come over to "[redacted] house" and he had a "bat." Everett believed he had something else but did not provide what it was. He stated that when squirrel was picked up "[redacted] and [redacted] ended up breaking his neck in the car." Everett then stated that "they" panicked and made a phone call because they did not know what to do. In response to the phone call, Everett stated that "they were told to put him on the railroad tracks." Det. Boehler asked "do you know why they broke his neck, what happened?" Everett's response to this question was, "yeah, I know about it." Everett did not begin answering the question immediately and hesitated, so I asked "why?" Everett responded, "well I don't want to tell you everything, and if I aint going to get help with what I got going on." I told Everett that he could not withhold information and I promise him something. Everett wanted to be reassured that he was going to get something for speaking with me and I again told him I needed the information first. Everett did request something to drink, and a cup of water was retrieved for him.

Everett provided information that the murder occurred over a "girl." I asked Everett what girl it was over. Everett responded that it was [redacted]'s girl. I asked what happened and Everett stated that "DJ was fucking her." I asked if that was it and that they were just having a relationship and Everett confirmed with "yeah." I asked if "they" planned to kill "DJ" in response to Everett providing the information earlier that [redacted] came over to "[redacted] house" with a "bat." Everett responded to my question with "yeah." I asked how they planned it and Everett again stated that [redacted] came over to [redacted] and obtained a "bat and tape." Everett continued the story stating that "they picked him up and told him they was going somewhere to a party." Everett further stated that "[redacted] dragged him from the back and had him in the front seat and [redacted] had him and they pulled over and killed him right there." I asked Everett how he knew so much about the murder, and he stated, "[redacted] told me." I asked Everett when "[redacted]" told him and Everett responded, "I've been living with [redacted] and [redacted] and [redacted] were living there too." I asked Everett if he still lived there, and he stated not technically but stayed there sometimes. I asked who "[redacted]" was and he stated, "[redacted]." Everett provided understanding that [redacted]'s mom has a couple rooms that he rents out. I asked if [redacted] lived at [redacted] and Everett stated that he was kicked out. I asked if he lived at [redacted] when the murder happened, and Everett was not sure. I asked how long Everett lived at [redacted]'s and he stated, "a good year, year and a half." I asked if he knew the individuals well and he responded, "oh yeah." Everett stated that [redacted] has no where to stay and that he works at Patricks Automotive. Everett further stated that Mikey is staying out at "[redacted]'s Lake and sleeping in a car." Everett confirmed that [redacted] and [redacted] are sleeping in a car. I asked Everett to describe [redacted] and he said she was petite, short dark hair that is shaved.

I stopped Everett from speaking at this point and told him that due to him knowing details and having intimate knowledge that I needed to know if he was involved in the murder. Everett confirmed that he was not involved in the murder in any way. Everett stated that he was "pissed off because they did what they did to him." I asked why? Everett stated because the "boy never had a chance, right is right and wrong is wrong." I asked how long this happened and he stated he did not know exactly but believed it

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was two years ago. Everett stated that there were other people involved in the crime, but he did not want to say anything about them because they just gave advice. I asked who gave advice? Everett responded people with "HA" and confirmed it was Hells Angels. I asked Everett why Hells Angels would give advice on a murder, and Everett responded, "I don't know." Det. Boehler asked who did they give advice to? Everett then stated he did not want to talk about that, and maybe they have somebody in Dorchester County. I told Everett that I needed to understand were individuals in the car calling the Hells Angels trying to figure out where to put the body? In response to this question Everett began shaking and rubbing his hands together and stated that I was right. I could see that Everett appeared to be afraid or uncomfortable with this line of questions during the conversation. His body posture was changing to defensive he was starring at the floor and began to take a more defensive posture. Everett's shaking became worse, visibly trying to keep his hands from shaking. Everett's breathing increased and I kept asking him about the phone call to the Hells Angels. Everett at this point requested to go back to his cell. The conversation was ended, and Everett allowed to go back with Jail staff. My body camera was turned off at this time and docked upon returning to the CID office.
