**ORDER GRANTING PARKER'S  
DEFENDANTS' MOTION FOR RULE  
TO SHOW CAUSE**

This matter arose from an ongoing discovery dispute over the deposition of non-party Mandy Matney originally scheduled for November 5, 2025. Ms. Matney, through her counsel, filed several motions with the Court seeking to quash or limit the deposition, which were denied. On March 16, 2026, the Court ordered Ms. Matney to sit for a deposition within 14 days. The deposition was noticed for March 27, 2026. However, Ms. Matney did not appear at the deposition on March 27, 2026, at the noticed location in Bluffton.

On March 30, 2026, Defendants Gregory M. Parker, Gregory M. Parker, Inc. d/b/a Parker's Corporation, Blake Greco, and Jason D'Cruz (collectively, the "Parker's Defendants") filed a Motion for Rule to Show Cause ("Motion") as to why Ms. Matney should not be held in contempt for failing to comply with the subpoena and the Court's March 16, 2026 Order. After the motion

was fully briefed, on April 7, 2026, the Court conducted an evidentiary hearing at which testimony was taken, including sworn testimony from Ms. Matney.

After carefully considering the Motion, Ms. Matney's Response and Supplemental Response, Ms. Matney's Affidavits, the record, the arguments of counsel, and the testimony presented at the April 7, 2026 hearing, it is undisputed that despite a valid subpoena, Ms. Matney did not attend the deposition at the noticed location in Bluffton. Accordingly, the Court finds that the Parker's Defendants have met their burden of establishing that Ms. Matney's disobeyed both a valid subpoena and this Court's March 16, 2026 Order.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that a Rule to Show Cause is granted requiring Mandy Matney to appear on May 15, 2026 at 10 AM in the Moss Justice Center, located at 1675 York Hwy # 1D, York, South Carolina 29745 before the Hampton County Court of Common Pleas **AS INDICATED IN THE FORTHCOMING NOTICE OF HEARING** to show cause, if she can, as to why she should not be held in contempt of court for willfully failing to comply with the duly issued subpoena requiring her to appear for a deposition on March 27, 2026, at the noticed location and the March 16, 2026 Order of this Court and sanctioned as provided under the laws of this State.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that service of this Rule to Show Cause Order may be made upon Mandy Matney's attorneys of record.

**AND IT IS SO ORDERED.**
