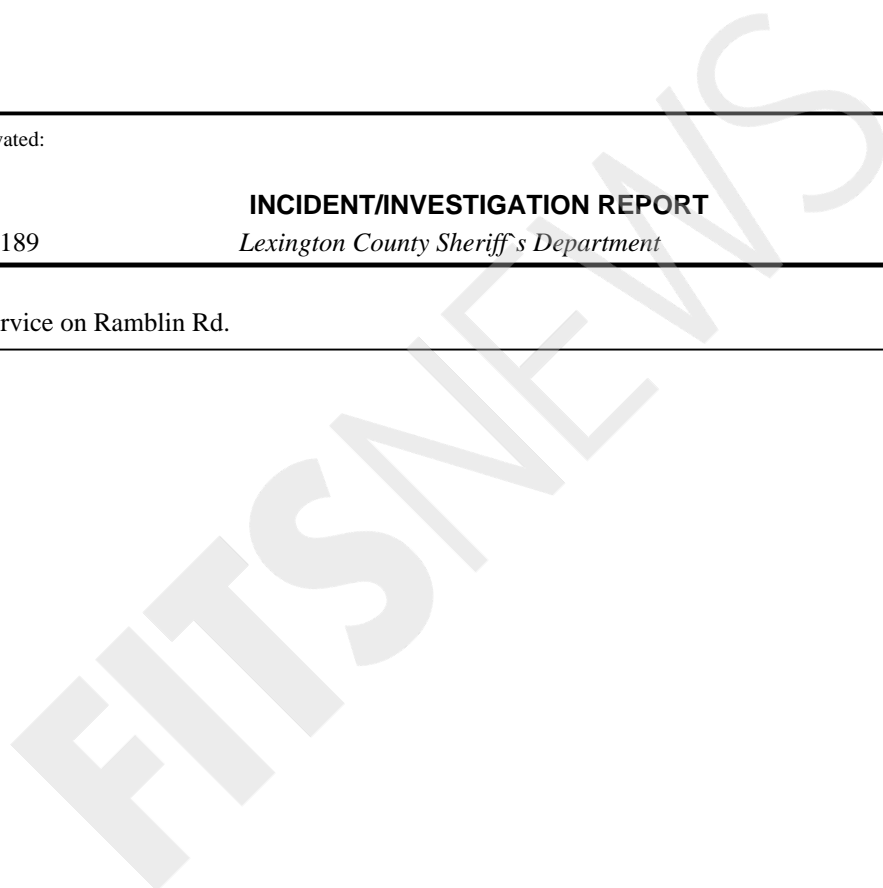

On 4/22/2026, I responded to a call for a home invasion on 7 [REDACTED] Ramblin Rd, South Congaree, SC, in the county of Lexington. Due to the nature of the call, I responded code 3.

I arrived on scene and found the front door open. I looked through the door from a distance and saw a white male sitting in a chair holding a gun. I waited for additional units to arrive. Upon another unit arriving, I gave loud and clear commands to the man to drop the gun from outside the home. He complied, then I told him to raise both hands until we got inside and not to reach for anything. Deputy Neeley and I entered the home and secured the weapon. I identified the man as Brian Jackson. He stated that he shot seven times down his hallway to trap them in the room. I sent Brian outside to another deputy while Deputy Neeley and I cleared the home. The home was secure, and no one was inside.

Upon talking with Brian, he informed me that there was a man and his family in the home showering. He stated he spoke with the man and told him to get his kids and wife out of the house and for him to leave because he didn't want to shoot the kids or women. Brian then stated he shot seven times down the hall to scare them. He stated that he still heard them inside and that they are hiding in the closet. I heard nothing inside the home. He then stated that there was a fire in the back room. I went and checked there was no fire. Brian has a signal 12 history, and due to his comments and seeing things, CCRI was notified at 0505. Brian's brother, Brent Jackson, arrived on scene and informed me that this has been going on for a while, and he is concerned for his brother's safety and his dad's who normally lives with Brian, but is out of town right now. Brent stated that he suspects Brian is using drugs and knows for a fact that he doesn't take his prescription medicine as prescribed and drinks way too much.

CCRI arrived on the scene. After CCRI talked with Brian and family members, they deemed it best to get a part one detention order. We received a part one in hand, and day shift officers took over the scene from there.

Pictures were taken of the scene and the bullet holes in the home. It appeared that one bullet went through the exterior wall of the home in the direction of Edmund Hwy. Between the house and Edmund Hwy is a dense tree line. It appeared that Brian shot more than seven times when walking around the home. He stated he shot his pistol and both shotguns until they were empty.

BWC was worn and active during this call for service.
